Project Summary

Funded by the 2016 Transportation Sales Tax, Charleston
County's US 17 & Main Road Corridor Segment A Project includes
roadway improvements with directional interchange flyover off
ramps from the north and southbound directions of US 17 to
Main Road, a Main Road spur bridge overpassing US 17, roadway
widening throughout the corridor, a roundabout at Main and
River Roads, a robust network of bike and pedestrian
connections, and necessary stormwater drainage
improvements.



Recent Activities

- Clearing is complete. Installation and maintenance of silt/barrier fencing continues.
- Temporary trestle bridge system is 95% constructed.
- Pile driving for ramp construction is underway.
- Utility relocations for St. Johns waterline are 60% complete.
- Main Road Ramp Bridge RFC Plans have been submitted to SCDOT for approval.

Upcoming Milestones

- Roadway plans completed by end of 2025.
- Approved ACOE and SCDES permit modifications expected by end of 2025.
 Roadway work will begin thereafter.
- Construction of Main/River/Chisolm Road roundabout will begin.
- Utility coordination and relocations will continue.
